Now offering 5% off our summer lodging rates and no conference fee (a savings of \$38/day per adult).

Our summer food program is \$48 per day for adults, \$39 per day for youth over 8, under age 8 eat free. Immediate families staying in a dorm room together, would pay for no more than 4 members for food, regardless of how many immediate family members came for the 4 nights. (Ex. A family of 6, 2 adults and 4 children all over 8 would only pay for 2 adults and 2 youth for food for the days you are here. Adults would be charged first, so, if your immediate family had 4 adults and 2 kids, you would only pay for 4 adults).
