Ferry Beach Restated Articles of Incorporation

Submission -- Exhibit A

- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation is organized and shall
 at all times be operated exclusively within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and within the meaning of Maine Revised Statutes Title
 13-B, Section 201, as amended.
- The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to fulfill the Mission of the corporation. The mission of the corporation is as follows: The Ferry Beach Park Association awakens hearts to explore, grow and renew the spirit of universal love.
- 3. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, director or officer of the corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the corporation) and no member, director, trustee or officer shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the corporation.
- 4. The corporation shall have classes of membership as defined in its Bylaws.
- 5. In the case of the dissolution of The Ferry Beach Park Association, all of the property of the Ferry Beach Park Association, whether real or personal property, funds and assets, will be transferred to an appropriate nonprofit entity as determined by the Board of Directors in office at the time of dissolution on the condition that said property will be used for the purposes stated in Article II of the Bylaws. This dissolution provision shall apply to all property donated to Ferry Beach, whether by will or in some other manner, unless the donor has expressly provided otherwise at the time of the donation.

Members of Ferry Beach Park Association

Anyone can become a member of Ferry Beach Park Association who is over 18 years of age. The way they can become a member is either to:

- 1) Pay \$1000 are considered Life Members. As such, these members do not need to pay their membership fee annually.
- 2) Individuals pay \$30 and families pay \$50 to be members

Members have the right to vote at the Annual Meeting of the Ferry Beach Park Association.
